Key Responsibilities

1. Strategic Leadership & Governance

- Oversee financials and recommend strategic reinvestments into the supply chain community.

2. Membership, Marketing & Sponsorship Growth

- Actively promote SAPICS and its value proposition to potential corporate members.
- Assist in securing sponsorships for SAPICS initiatives, including conferences and events.
- Leverage personal and professional networks to expand SAPICS's reach and influence.
- Share SAPICS posts on social media. List SAPICS Director on your LinkedIn profile. Tag SAPICS in posts on social media about your SAPICS experiences.
- Be prepared to give input into SAPICS press releases and to give comment or be quoted in relevant articles.
- SAPICS offers a complimentary individual membership to the Board member

3. Event Attendance & Participation

- **Annual SAPICS Conference attendance is expected.**
 - SAPICS covers the cost of a conference registration and the Closing dinner.
 - Travel and accommodation costs are the responsibility of the board member.
 - Attendance at events, webinars and workshops is expected during the term of office.

4. Operational Pillar Oversight

- Each board member will take ownership of an operational pillar within SAPICS.
- This involves contributing to the development and execution of strategies within their assigned area.

5. Board Meetings & Time Commitment

- Attend monthly board meetings.
- Participate in operational pillar meetings, typically once or twice a month (each lasting about an hour).
- Be available to provide oversight and strategic input as needed.

- Actively advocate for SAPICS and the supply chain profession.
- Demonstrate a commitment to SAPICS's growth and sustainability.
- Serve as a visible and engaged ambassador for SAPICS within the industry.
